

The organic family olive grove of the Karalis family dates back to the early 1900s and is located on a small hill near the port of Mytilini with a limestone substrate. Our trees grow amphitheatrically on successive stone terraces (setia) forming a wonderful landscape.

The fruit of our olive oil is the product of special care and respect for the land where we grew. The cultivation of our olive grove is organic, with certification since 2000 and the pressing of the fruit is done from the collection of early olives due to the low acidity they produce and is carried out in a certified olive press for organic olive oils in Mytilini.

The method of cold pressing is followed in order to produce a superior quality whose purity has not been affected by high temperatures or the use of chemicals, in order to preserve the beneficial antioxidants and nutrients of the olive oil.
